YES	Ohm Meter
YES	Manifold Gauge Set (Preferably Single Refrigerant or Digital)
YES	Clamp On Temperature Probes (For Linesets)
YES	Insertion Temperature Probes (For Airflow Type K Thermocouple OK)
YES	Amperage Clamp
YES	Temperature Probes to Measure Wet Bulb Temperatures
YES	(Working) Vaccum Pump
YES	Micron Guage
YES	Inclined Manometer, U-Tube Manometer, Or Magnehelic Guage
YES	Digital Meter that Can Measure Pressure Differential
YES	Pitot Tubes For Pressure Differential Devices
YES	Gas Pressure Guage
YES	Recovery Machine
YES	Empty Recovery Cylinder

This list is the minimum tools that any qualified technician should have in their possession if they are servicing HVAC equipment. Should a tool be required to complete a site visit, and the technician on the job does not have it, the site visit cannot be completed and will have to be rescheduled for a later date and an 185.00 dollar service fee will be assessed at the time of the site visit and a PO must be issued by the Service Company to Carrrier Enterprise.

A limited supply of tools may be purchased on the jobsite from the Customer Assurance Manager with a PO if you have the proper account type. There is no guarantee that these will be available at all times.
